According to the NIH, fentanyl is a powerful synthetic opioid that is FDA-approved to treat severe pain related to surgery or complex pain conditions. Drug overdose fatalities exceeded auto accidents as a cause of death for the first time in 2016. Illegally manufactured fentanyl is chiefly responsible for the current crisis. Opioid-involved overdose deaths have risen from 21,089 in 2010 to 80,411 in 2021.



Just 2 to 3 milligrams of fentanyl, comparable to 5 to 7 grains of salt, can induce respiratory depression, arrest, and death. NIOSH recommends always wearing nitrile gloves when illicit drugs may be present and change them properly when the gloves become contaminated. This helps prevent exposures to these illicit drugs.

ILLICIT DRUGS CAN BE IN POWDER, PILL, OR LIQUID FORMS. LAW ENFORCEMENT, PUBLIC WORKS EMPLOYEES, AND OTHERS CAN COME INTO CONTACT BY:

- > Breathing (Inhalation)
- > Eating (Ingestion)
- > Touching eyes, nose, or mouth with contaminated hands or gloves or when illicit drugs come into contact with the eyes, nose, or mouth directly (Mucosal)
- > Liquid illicit drugs may be absorbed by the skin (Dermal)
- > Being stuck by a needle (Percutaneous)
